**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING
SECTION 4-02-16.A.1 OF THE MAPLE PARK VILLAGE CODE
REGARDING HOURS OF OPERATION IN THE LIQUOR CONTROL CHAPTER**

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees of the Village of Maple Park, Illinois has determined that it is in the best interest and welfare of the citizens of the Village of Maple Park, to regulate the use, consumption, sale and distribution of liquor in the Village of Maple Park; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees deems it appropriate to make the following revisions of the Liquor Control chapter of the Maple Park Village Code.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Maple Park, Illinois as follows:

Section One: That Section 4-2-16, Paragraph A, subsection 1 of Chapter 2 of Title 4 of the Maple Park Village Code is hereby amended in its entirety to hereinafter read as follows:

4-2-16: Hours of Operation.

A. Hours Specified:

1. Licensees may conduct business operation in accordance with this Chapter and laws of the State of Illinois on Monday through Thursday between the hours of six o'clock (6:00) a.m. and one o'clock (1:00) a.m., of the following day; and on Friday and Saturday between the hours of six o'clock (6:00) a.m. and two o'clock (2:00) a.m., of the following day; and on Sunday between the hours of eleven o'clock (11:00) a.m. and eleven o'clock (11:00) p.m. It shall be unlawful to sell or offer for sale, at retail, any alcoholic liquor in the Village of Maple Park between the hours of two o'clock (2:00) a.m. and eleven o'clock (11:00) a.m. on Sunday and between the hours of eleven o'clock (11:00) p.m. Sunday and six o'clock (6:00) a.m. on Monday.
2. However, during the village's annual festival and street dance during Labor Day Weekend (Fun Fest), licensees may conduct business from eleven o'clock (11:00) a.m. on Sunday until twelve o'clock midnight (12:00).

Section Two:

This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its passage, approval and publication as required by law. All ordinances and parts of ordinances in conflict or inconsistent with the provisions of this ordinances are hereby repealed to the extent of any such conflict or inconsistency. If any part or portion of this ordinance shall be declared invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, such partial invalidity shall not affect the remainder of this ordinance. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication in pamphlet form as hereby authorized to be done by the President and Board of Trustees.

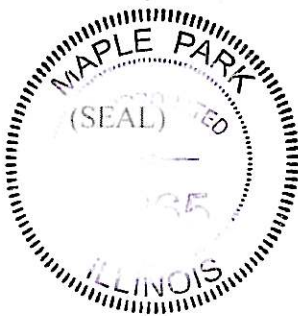
